INSTRUCTIONS FOR AFFIDAVIT OF DEFENSE OR ADMISSION AND WAIVER OF APPEARANCE

Any defendant charged with an infraction may, in lieu of a personal appearance at trial, file an affidavit of defense or an admission that the infraction was committed.

This form is for civil infractions that *do not require a mandatory appearance* before the court. This form <u>cannot</u> be used for criminal citations.

- 1. Complete the form. Attach any additional papers, documents, photos, etc.
- 2. Have the form notarized or sign before a deputy clerk. If the form is signed before a deputy clerk a \$3.50 fee will be charged and due at the time of signing.
- 3. Be sure to include an email address unless you have been excused from service by email. Following the hearing, you will be served by a copy of the court's decision.
- 4. Mail (if notarized) or bring the form to file in your court record at one of the following locations:
