Subject: Report on Counts of Clerk Change Funds

We conducted surprise cash counts of change funds for both Central Cashiering locations on April 5, 2022. The purpose of these counts is to periodically verify the existence and amounts of these change funds and to observe, to the extent possible, the cash collection procedures in place while observing the physical safeguards in place. This review does not constitute a full review of all cash collection procedures. Such would be the subject of a separate engagement.

We compared amounts recorded in the General Ledger as change funds to the amounts held at the Cashiering locations. The results of the unannounced cash counts were <u>excellent</u> with no variations at either location.

We would like to thank management and staff at both collection locations for their assistance and cooperation.
