Re: Judicial Sales, 45.031 Florida Statutes

Effective August 1, 2022, the Okaloosa County Clerk of Court will no longer issue the Notice of Sale. The plaintiff is responsible for the issuance of the Notice of Sale and having it published. The Notice of Sale should be filed immediately into the case after being issued. The Notice of Sale is required to comply with all provisions set forth in section 45.031(2), Florida Statutes. The plaintiff must ensure that the original affidavit of proof of publication is filed with the clerk by 5pm the day prior to the sale. If this deadline cannot be met, you must contact the Clerk's office immediately.

The Okaloosa County Clerk of Court will issue the Certificates of Sale, Title, and Disbursements as required by statute.
