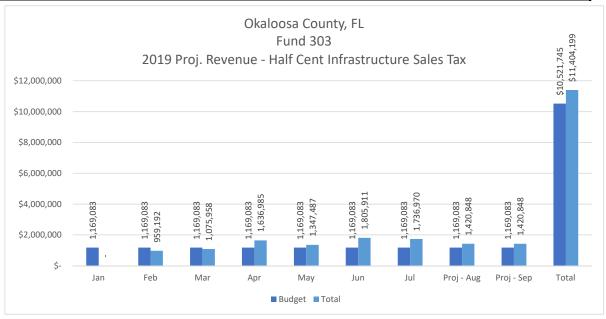
Okaloosa County Infrastructure Sales Surtax Summary Financial Report Fund = 303 September 2019 Meeting

Additional project revenue comes from various sources to include State and Federal Grants, Triumph Gulf Coast and collaboration from Muncipalities.

In addition, budgeted revenues not yet dedicated to a specific project are maintained in a Reserves/Miscellaneous Department (3399).
